Main task

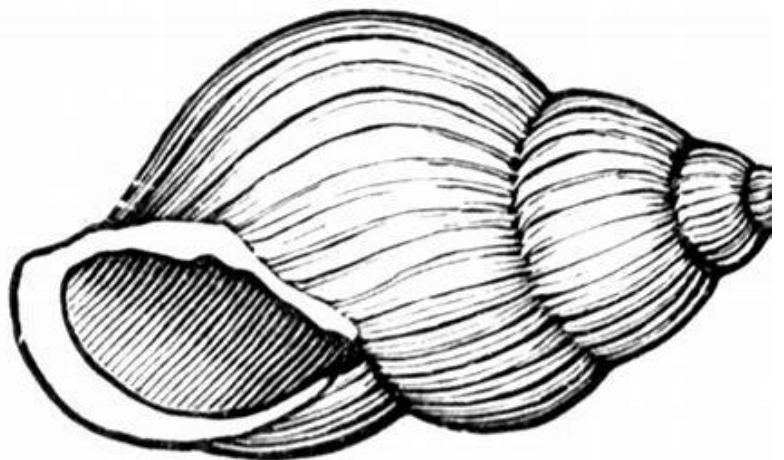
Crab, grass, star fish, snail, eel, clown fish, cod.
