Dear Parents,

In school it is 'business as usual' whilst taking extra precautions to ensure the safety of the children, the staff and our parents.

- Please continue to make sure that your child washes their hands with soap and water at home and that they do so after using the toilet, before eating a meal and at various other times inbetween. *In school we are insisting on this good practice too.*
- **If you or your child has a new cough or has a raised temperature or both, please keep your child at home and also stay at home yourself for 14 days.** Please see the latest 'Stay at home' online guidance from the government if you require additional information.

In school the water fountains have been turned off as part of our safety measures. Children will have access to water at lunch time. We ask that you send your child to school with their own water bottle so that they can drink from that. Staff will happily refill bottles when required.

Oak Assembly

The children in Oak class treated us to a dinosaur-themed assembly on Friday of last week and we were all very joyful at seeing their art work, listening to their songs and hearing about the attributes of dinosaurs. Thank you to the children and staff in Oak class for this opportunity.
