Contact, track and trace

As we make preparations to prepare for being at home over the Christmas holidays, please could I ask you to read carefully the contact, track and trace information below so that you can act appropriately if your child contracts Covid-19 and school can carry out the appropriate notifications to other groups within the school. I hope and pray that everybody keeps well and safe over the holidays but this is one of my responsibilities as Head of the Infant School. If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) during the school holidays, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

For the first 6 days after school ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school will assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. If you need to update this, please contact the school office before the end of term.
