Changes to school dates for the academic year 2021-2022

Due to changes in the calendar for occasional days, I would like to draw your attention to some changes from the published dates on the school website. The children will now start back to school on <u>Tuesday 7th September 2021</u>, there will be an additional non-pupil day <u>on Friday 22nd</u> <u>October 2021</u> and the children will be expected to be in school on <u>Monday 25th April 2022</u> as this will now revert to a normal teaching day.

School Class Photographs

If you wish to order a class photograph through school, please note that the order deadline is the morning of Tuesday 15th June. Orders after this date will need to be made directly with the company and will incur postage costs.

<u>Start times</u>

A reminder to everyone of the soft start times that are in place currently. Years 1 and 2 will be welcomed into the classrooms from 8.50 until 9.00 and Early Years from 9.05 until 9.15. Key Stage 1 children will be marked as late if they arrive after 9.00 and early years children will be marked as late if they arrive after 9.15. Between Monday and Thursday of this week the office staff recorded more than six and a half hours of lateness in total, which is the equivalent of more than a whole day of teaching time, with associated disruption to teaching and loss of teaching assistant time when they need to collect children from the gate. Please ensure that your child arrives on time for school, as being late often causes them to feel unsettled and does not give a good start to the day. This particularly applies to those children who are consistently late on a regular, sometimes daily basis. The school is obliged to report persistent lateness to the Educational Welfare Officer.

<u>Parking</u>

Parking on the yellow lines opposite the school gates on Hermitage Lane is continuing to cause congestion on the road, which in turn is putting the children in danger. Please find a safer place to park and walk into school, for the safety of all.

It looks as if the weather may be much warmer and sunnier next week – don't forget to apply sunscreen before the children come to school, send in sun hats and if you wish they may wear light long sleeve tops for additional protection.
