Contact, track and trace

Please follow the advice below:

If your child tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) during the school holidays, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, the school should not be contacted. Parents and carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace. For the first 6 days after school ends, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school will assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school. In this event, we would contact parents using the information stored on the school data system. If you need to update this, please contact the school office before the end of term.

Y2 to Y3 Transfer

All parents with children in Y2 need to complete the Plymouth City Council online form so that your child can transfer into the Junior School. Please do this as soon as possible and don't wait for the 15th January deadline. The online form is simple to complete and found under Plymouth City Council followed by Admissions. If you are experiencing difficulties, my staff in the office will happily talk you through the process over the phone when we return to school in January. Returning to school

All safety measures will need to remain in place with the existing staggered starts and masks for all adults please (except those who are medically exempt). When children return to school, please remind them of the need to wash hands frequently and to stay close to you in the playground in the mornings and for afternoon pick up.
