We also need to say a very big well done to the Year 2 children, who have all taken part in the phonic screening check. They all did extremely well and showed the progress they had made in their phonic skills since the beginning of the year, with 91% of them reaching the required standard.

Return in January

A reminder that the children return to school on Thursday 6th January, when we will be greeting our new Executive Head teacher, Mrs Yvonne Jones. We will be continuing with our 'soft start', so the children can begin to come into school from 8.45. The start period ends at 9am and the children need to be in school by this time as this is when formal teaching session begin. The children find it unsettling if they arrive after the teaching session has begun. In January we will be reducing the length of the lunchtime from one hour and twenty-five minutes to one hour. The children will still have the same amount of time to eat their lunch, as the hour will be staggered with different timings for Early Years and KS1.
