In Science, Year 2 have been sorting food into various groups. The children were able to talk about foods that we need to stay healthy and foods that are not healthy.



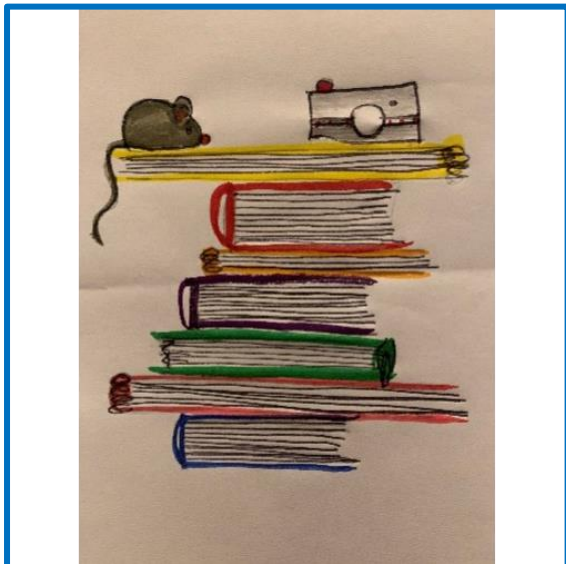
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Go Read competition
