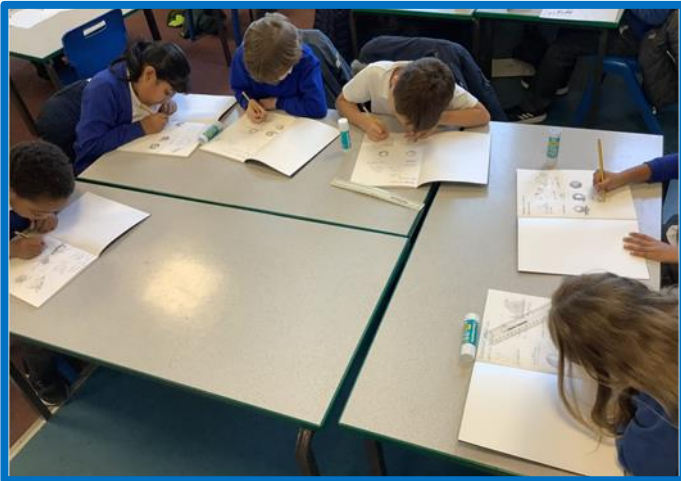

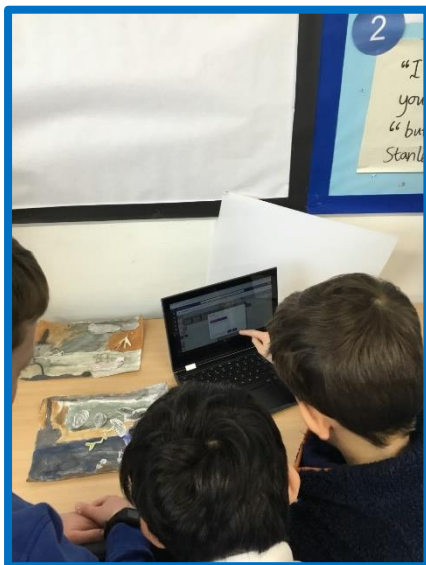
Love for Art
