# **Mass & Scales**

In Year 2, last term the children focussed on the different units we use to measure things. In lessons the children measured the length and height of objects using centimetres and metres. They also used scales and measuring mass in grams and kilograms. The children used ordinary scales to measure the mass of everyday classroom objects.

The end of last term our children in Year 1 visited Dartmoor Zoo. Despite the rainy weather the children were able to see lots of animals such as lions, a tiger, wolves, and an otter to name a few. 
