Physically Active

In PE sessions, Reception children have been focusing on Nursery Rhymes and have performed actions for their nursery rhymes to their peers.



Being physically active can improve your brain health, help manage weight, reduce the risk of disease, strengthen bones and muscles, and improve your ability to do everyday activities.

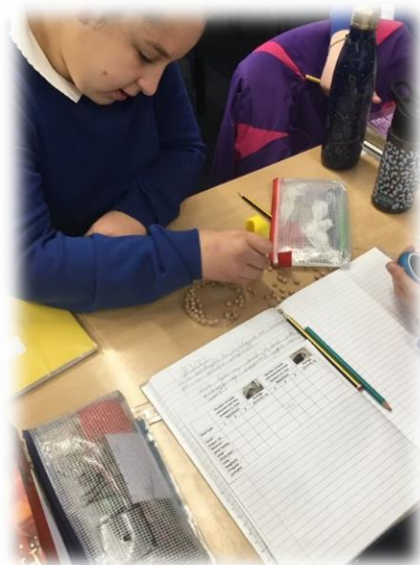
Bread Baking

In Year 2, the children made bread as part of their Design & Technology unit of work. The children have learnt about yeast and how it makes bread rise. The children evaluated the bread made based on taste, texture, and appearance. The children will then move on to design packaging for their bread.



Science Experiment

This term, Year 6 children have been learning about Darwin's theories of evolution and natural selection. Focusing on adaptation (how an organism is suited to its environment), the children conducted an investigation to simulate the investigations Darwin carried out into the finches of the Galapagos. The children used different tweezers, representing beaks, and different seeds to test which type of beak was best suited to which food.

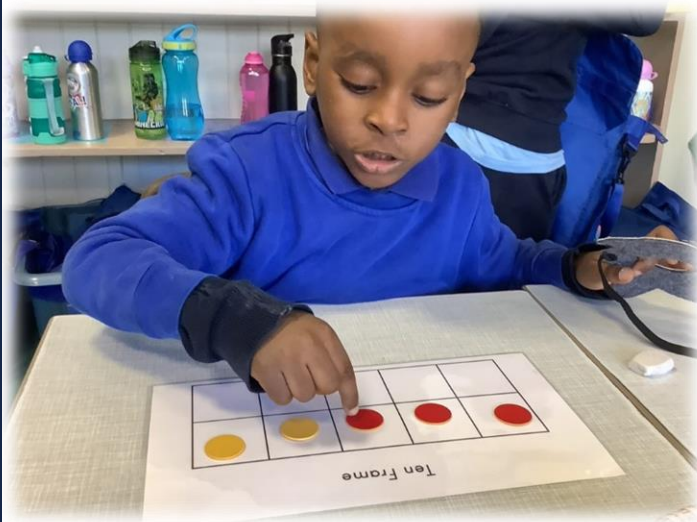


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Number Bonds

In Reception the children have been exploring the use of 5 and 10s frames and working on their number bonds to 10.

Across Hyde Park Schools, Maths is one of the favourite subjects for many children.



Sing counting songs or rhymes at home. For example, 'Five Little ducks', 'One, Two, Buckle my Shoe' or 'Ten Green Bottles'. Repeat the same songs or rhymes on a regular basis and use finger actions to show the mathematical meaning of the words.

Design & Technology

In recent DT lessons, Year 1 children learnt how to do a running stitch and practised on binka. The children have thoroughly enjoyed these lessons.
