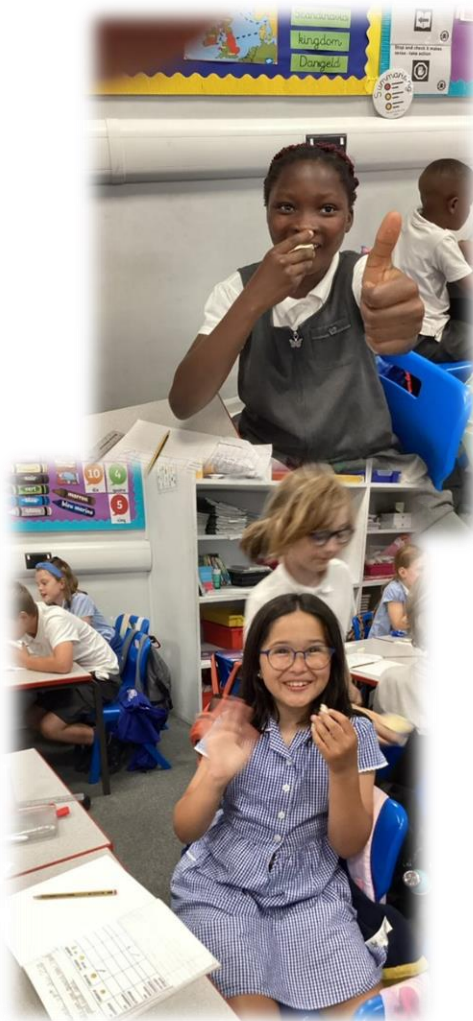
## Personal Development

### 1. Develop family reading routines and rituals

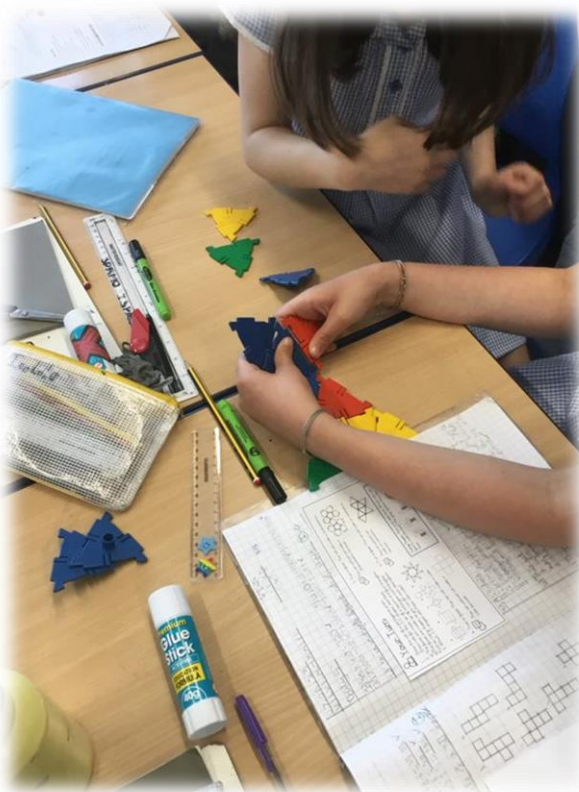
Find a regular time of day when you can incorporate a dedicated story time into your day. You can read in the morning, after school, or before bedtime! Making story time a cozy routine makes reading an essential and pleasant activity.

### 2. Read what interests your child

The nutrition facts on the milk box, newspapers, recipes, maps, and game instructions all make great reading material if your child is interested.

## Maths

Our SATs may be over, but Year 6 are still working hard! In recent Maths lesson, the children have been putting their problem-solving skills to good use with investigations into geometry. Using physical resources to help, the children have investigated volume, finding all possible nets of cubes and finding nets of other 3D shapes – including dodecahedrons!



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### Science in the Park

Recently, Year 2 took their Science learning to the park. The children used techniques such as quadrants, binary identification keys and a tree identification from a guide. One group managed to find all the trees in the guide! It was a really enjoyable afternoon, and everyone including teachers learnt a lot about scientific enquiry.


