#### **Plants & Animals**

In Mathematics, Reception children have been learning to find the total of two sets. Using concrete manipulatives, the children have been creating different ways of making numbers up to 10.



#### Music

In music, children in Reception have been exploring different instruments. As a class, they have been learning the names of the instruments, listening to the sounds they make and working as a group to create short musical pieces. To further the children's learning, they have linked this with their topic of Dinosaurs this term and reasoning which instruments are best suited for each dinosaur depending on their size and how they would have moved through the jungles.



Do remember that you can continue these fun learning activities at home with the children.









#### **Lines of Symmetry**

Children in Year 2 have been learning about shape in Mathematics. The children can name the common 2D shapes and can explain if a shape has a line of symmetry. The children used mirrors to assist them to find a line of symmetry. The children have thoroughly enjoyed this unit of work.





#### **Gymnastics**

In PE, Year 3 children have been learning about symmetrical and asymmetrical balance. The children have been exploring how they could use their whole body in symmetrical and asymmetrical way. The children shared their examples with the class and thought about what went well and what could they do better next time.



#### **Gymnastics**

Year 5 children have been showing good progress of knowledge and skills through developing sequences involving counterbalances. The children have been learning to apply 'excellent gymnastics' - focussing on applying extension to their balances and moving in and out of their balances ensuring flow.












#### **Rowing**

Year 6 children recently had an experience of Indoor Rowing. Many of the children had never tried this before, but soon found an undiscovered talent! After a short practise, the children took part in simulated races; the competition was very strong!















#### **Looking After our Teeth**

In Science, Year 4 children carried out an investigation to explore why it is important to look after our teeth. The children covered hard boiled eggs in toothpaste and placed them into a variety of liquids, including tea, cola, vinegar and water. The children also submerged eggs with no toothpaste into the same type of bevarges in order to compare the effects. In another lesson, the children will wash the eggs, record and interpret their findings. We can't wait to hear all about their results!
