Plants


As part of Year 2 work about plants this term, the children learnt about house plants and the types of conditions they need to grow healthily. They also looked at some of the adaptations the plants had to grow in their natural habitat, such as fleshy leaves and roots that store water.





Some facts about plants. Can you think of others?

- Some plants are <u>carnivorous</u>. This means they eat other living things! They gain nutrients from some insects and spiders, e.g., Venus flytraps.
- b. Some plants have adapted to defend themselves from animals. Plant defences include stings and poisons.
- c. 80% of flowering plants are adapted for pollination by animals (mostly insects).
- d. <u>Honey bees</u> account for 80% of all insect pollination.
- Nearly all chocolate relies on midges pollinating the cocoa plant, which might make them seem slightly less annoying!
