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## **Sciencedipity Workshop**

Children in Year 1 all enjoyed a science workshop with Sciencedipity. The children shared their knowledge of materials and their properties and explored a range of different materials in their groups. The children investigated which materials were magnetic, waterproof and conduct electricity. Some children identified that "some metals can be bendy" and that "glass is not the only material that is transparent". The children also enjoyed exploring how some materials can change with heat too.


### **Netball**
