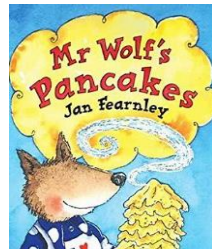
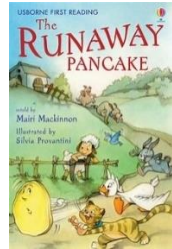
Enquiry Questions:
