
First Aid Course for parents

First Aid and Safety Awareness Club for Y2 children

In November Andy Tippet will be running 4 sessions of First Aid and Safety Awareness for 15 Y2 children on a Friday Lunchtime for 30 minutes allowing children to attend the club, eat lunch and still have some playtime. This is a new and exciting club for the school and if we are inundated with requests, Andy has promised that he will run another group for those who are unsuccessful the first time around. The club will run on 4th, 11th, 18th and 25th November and include a range of opportunities including bandaging and putting a patient into the recovery position.
