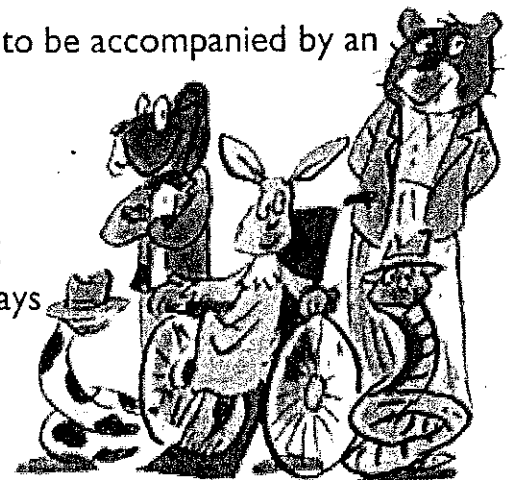


Summer Reading Challenge

Fact Sheet



- This year the Summer Reading Challenge theme is Animal Agents, with prizes to collect and crimes to solve, accompanied by original artwork from Tony Ross
- The aim is to encourage children to read 6 books or more during the summer holidays
- It can be any type of book, fiction or non-fiction
- Each child is given a record card that is updated each time they visit the library, and there are stickers and prizes to collect along the way
- After the first two books have been read children will be awarded with a door hanger for their room
- After they've read four books children will be given a folding game
- Once all six books have been read children will be given a keyring and a medal in the library, as well as a certificate that will be presented to them in a special school assembly in September/October
- It is free to join the library, children just need to be accompanied by an adult
- In addition to the above there will be several activities themed around the Summer Reading Challenge taking place over the summer holidays (Please enquire with individual libraries or see the Council's website for further information regarding specific activities)
