# Beginner First Aid Club

After half term there will be a new club running at lunchtime starting on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> November for Y2 and separately, for Y1 children. The children will learn to practically deal with simple first aid situations and learn how to apply a cold compress, a bandage and how to call for assistance. The club will be run by Andy Tippet, a qualified teacher, DBS cleared and First Aid tutor. There will be 4 sessions at a total cost of £12.00 payable in cash in advance. The club will run for approximately 30 minutes giving children ample time for their school lunch and some outdoor play too. Please secure your child's place in this beginner first aid club by sending £12.00 in an envelope and marking the outside of the envelope with First Aid Club, their name and class. Please send the envelope to the school office at any time next week although 'Early Birds' will be sure of securing a place.









#### Illnesses

Please be informed that a number of children have contracted **Chicken Pox.** They will need to stay at home for **f**ive days from the onset of the rash and until your child is well. There have also been a few cases of **Shingellosis**, a vomiting and diarrhoea bug that spreads quickly. The symptoms can last up to 7 days and diarrhoea can also cause dehydration.

For any illness involving diarrhoea or sickness, please ensure that your child is 48 hours clear of their last bout so that bacteria and infections are not spread at school and also, importantly, that your child only returns to school when they are fully recovered.

#### Open door policy

Staff try very hard to make themselves available to you before and after school and for the most part, this is working very well. Can I please ask that parents do not come into the cloakrooms or the classroom just before the bell is rung as staff need to encourage the children to show their independence and start the learning quickly at the beginning of the day.

I am hearing great news from the children and from parents about the success of the Hyde Park Explorers pack that has been distributed to all the children. There are plenty of activities to try out that can turn even the wettest of days into an exciting adventure.
