Therefore, could I please ask you to start sending in your contributions to our Food Bank Harvest this year. Every item needs to be of a long life variety so no fresh produce, please.

The items that we are collecting this year are as follows:-

Tinned vegetables
Tinned fruit
Tinned fish
Long life fruit juice
Long life milk
Tins or packets of biscuits
Packets or bags of cereals

Hot chocolate powder that can be mixed with hot water

Other tins, packets and bags of food that are long life will also be gratefully received. Please send in your donations in a carrier bag or box and place them at the front of the hall. Please leave the bag or box as it will be used to collect the food donations and send them to the Plymouth Food Bank. We will be collecting donations for two weeks starting on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> and finishing on Friday 19<sup>th</sup>. At various times children and families in this school have and are needing Food Bank support and I hope that you will be generous if you are in a position to share some of the itemised food. Thank you.

## Collection at the end of the day

Please be kind enough to inform us in writing/via e-mail if your child is not to be collected by their parent(s). If this is to be a regular occurrence, please write that on your note so that it can be logged in our school records.
