Year 1 Summer Term Home Learning Activities.

These are the activities that we would have been covering in the curriculum at school. Don't forget to utilise Twinkl as they will have a lot of useful resources for all subjects. Go to the **School closure home learning** page.

Maths- Multiplication

- Moving on to applying their multiplication knowledge to real life circumstances, such as
 using money to count in 2s, 5s and 10s, e.g. having a pile of 2p coins and asking how many
 you will need to make 20p, by counting in 2s.
- Giving them some real life problems such as, having 4 hands and asking how many fingers there are by counting in 5s.
- Building on arrays, introduce the multiplication sign (this is the first time they will be introduced to this sign formally). With reference to an egg box being 3 lots of 2, can they write the number sentence? 3 x 2 =

English- This term our History is taught through our English and this week we are looking at famous pirates, including Blackbeard.

- Research pirates online and try to find out who they were and what they did.
- You could design your own pirate flag and begin to write about what a pirate is and does.
- Research Blackbeard, draw a picture of him and write some facts about what he looked like, where he lived, what was his real name etc.
- Our grammar focus this week will be adding the prefix 'un' to words such as happy and changing it to the opposite, unhappy. And if able, writing it in a sentence.

Reading and spelling

- Please read with your child as often as possible. Remember to focus on sounding out and reblending unfamiliar words, recognising common exception words on sight, retelling the information/story that they have read, and answering comprehension and inference questions.
- Please continue to practice spelling a few of the common exception words each week.

Phonics

- In the Summer term, we would be focusing heavily on the phase 5 phonemes (you would have received these at parent's evening). There is a useful home learning pack on the Twinkl website called 'Phase 5 phonic activity booklet'.
- Don't forget to spot the phase 5 graphemes when reading your books.
- Phonicsplay has some useful activities and games that you can play at home.

In our foundation subjects we would have been focussing on; what a plant needs to grow (Water, light, etc), making an island collage picture and continuing to use the internet to organise and save work on their pirate powerpoint presentation. You may also want to talk about the Easter story or Easter celebrations.
